

The Details of the Trip

- The trip will take place from Sunday, October 19th, 2025, to Monday, October 27th, 2025.
- 8 nights, 9 days of culture and fun! Of course, if you would like to stay longer on your own, you can!

The rates are based on the occupancy and the number of stars of the hotel:

- 1. Total Price per person for a double room: 4-star hotel: \$ 3,000 per person including tax
- 2. Total Price per person for a single room: 4-star hotel: \$4,500 per person including tax

8-nights' accommodation at a centrally located hotel (either on Place du Capitole, or along the banks of the Garonne, or in the Renaissance quarter)

15 activities included but not limited to:

- Guided visits of sites/monuments/museums in Toulouse as well as in Carcassonne, Albi, Cordes-sur-Ciel, and Cahors, and two workshops (pastel and violette)
- Free time for your own leisure and shopping
- Daily breakfast
